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## PERFORMANCE NOTES

- The ‘aa’ in m. 33-37 should be the same vowel as in the beginning of the word ‘drown’. The idea is that the repetition of the word ‘drowning’ culminates in an ‘draa’, or in other words, the first ‘aa’ of the word.
  - The imitation of waves from m. 42 should be a very subtle sound. Like waves rolling slowly in and out on the beach. The number of singers doing this is up to the discretion of the conductor.
